

**PRAYER FOR PROTECTION FROM CORONAVIRUS**

O Mary, you shine continuously on our journey as a sign of salvation and hope. We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick. At the foot of the Cross you participated in Jesus' pain, with steadfast faith. You, Our Refuge and our Hope, know what we need. We are certain that you will provide, so that, as you did at Cana of Galilee, joy and feasting might return after this moment of trial. Help us, Mother of Divine Love, to conform ourselves to the Father's will and to do what Jesus tells us: He who took our sufferings upon Himself, and bore our sorrows to bring us, through the Cross, to the joy of the Resurrection. Amen.

**ATTENTION** The Archdiocese has resumed the celebration of Mass everyday. Social distancing is required with 6' separation between persons (except for family members from the same household); all worshippers are asked to wear a face mask and to keep it on during Mass, moving it down to your chin only to receive Holy Communion. (If anyone disagrees about the necessity of wearing a face mask—wear it anyway— out of respect for and charity towards their fellow parishioners.) Hymnals, missalettes, holy water are removed from the church; and the church will be sanitized between services. After Mass, please do not congregate in the church or outside but make your way home. During the Mass, please do not hold hands or exchange the Sign of Peace. The celebrant will not use a face mask while on the altar, but he and other ministers will when they distribute Holy Communion. The dispensation from the obligation of attending Mass on Sunday continues indefinitely. Use good judgement. *If you are sick please stay home.* If you are frail because of age or are vulnerable because of an underlying condition, or you are a caretaker of someone who is, it might be reasonable to stay home.
